3. Indian-origin Canadian politician Anita Anand was appointed as the new Defence Minister of Canada in the latest cabinet reshuffle by Prime Minister Justin Trudeau.
4. Sarbananda Sonowal, Minister of Ayush and Ports, Shipping and Waterways inaugurated the Incubation Centre for Innovation and Entrepreneurship (AIIA- iCAINE) at All India Institute of Ayurveda (AIIA), at a program organized in Vigyan Bhavan, New Delhi.
