



The Hindu Vocabulary- 05.11.2017

1. FOLKLORIC (ADJECTIVE): *fairy-tale*

Synonyms: chimerical, fanciful

Antonyms: factual, real

Example Sentence:

She loves watching folkloric movies.

2. TRADUCE (VERB): *violate*

Synonyms: defame, slander

Antonyms: compliment, flatter

Example Sentence:

They traduced her.

3. REFRACTORY (ADJECTIVE): *disobedient*

Synonyms: mulish, headstrong

Antonyms: obedient, manageable

Example Sentence:

He is a refractory child.

4. INCONGRUOUS (ADJECTIVE): *out of place*

Synonyms: incoherent, incompatible

Antonyms: matched, compatible

Example Sentence:

The duffel coat looked incongruous.

5. DISSEMINATION (NOUN): *distribution*

Synonyms: promulgation, propagation

Synonyms: collection, gathering

Example Sentence:

You once mentioned considering the dissemination of miss information.

6. CONFOUNDING (VERB): *astonish*

Synonyms: astound, amaze

Antonyms: getting bore, being bother

Example Sentence:

She was confounding with the gifts she got.

7. CORROBORATION (NOUN): *confirmation*

Synonyms: validation, verification

Antonyms: denial, negation

Example Sentence:

There is no independent corroboration for this task.

8. ESPOUSE (VERB): *stand up for*

Synonyms: advocate, adopt

Antonyms: disagree, disallow

Example Sentence:

She will espouse this matter.

9. DISPEL (VERB): *dismiss*

Synonyms: disperse, dissipate

Antonyms: collect, gather

Example Sentence:

They were dispelled from the meeting.

10. APLOMB (NOUN): *assurance*

Synonyms: equanimity, nonchalance

Antonyms: fear, gaucheness

Example Sentence:

She treated the matter with aplomb.
